
Doc 3: Euro-Catholic iconography: "The Black Madonna and Child". Why do these white people worship a Black woman and her Black child?

Doc 4: The Hebrew Yeshua. Who was he?


Doc 5: The Coptic Joshua, who was he?




Ironically, the most compelling evidence that Jesus was Black, is not to be found in Africa, Middle East, or even the Levant; but in the whitest European countries, which pioneered and perpetrated the white concept of the saviour they call Jesus Christ; and his blonde-blue eyed iconography.



Yeshua was the son of Mary, widely portrayed by Europeans, such as: French, Czechs, Poles, Spanish, Portuguese, Croatians, Belgians, Hungarians, Irish etc, as The Black Madonna. These European countries adorn their holy places with pictures of the Black Nazarene virgin— mother of Jesus. Though some Europeans and other peoples have denied the Black Madonna and painted her white; many images of her blackness exist today. Reportedly, there have been in existence at one time or t'other 450 Black Madonnas, mostly in Europe; 272 or which are in France.





Russia recently opened up their "Jesus archives" for scholarship or research. By all accounts, it rivals the Vatican archives, known to have the most authentic evidence of Yeshua, the Black Judean, whose iconography has purportedly been misrepresented by Leonardo Da Vinci— commissioned in the 15th Century by Pope Alexander Sixth (AKA Rodrigo Borgia), to paint the likeness of Jesus the Christ, as his (Pope's) second son Cesare Borgia. The series also draws on biblical veracity, which describes Jesus as follows:

"Jesus's skin was a darker hue and his hair was woolly in texture. The hairs of his head, it says, "were white as white wool, white as snow. His eyes were like a flame of fire, his feet were like burnished bronze, refined as in a furnace."
